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How do we deal with self's battle between good and evil? The answer lies in our identity in Christ as new creatures. Paul has already told us to "put off" the old, be "renewed," and "put on" the new man (4:22-24). He now goes on to identify the areas of struggle and show how we can deal with them so we can grow and glorify God.

DISHONESTY (v. 25)

"Put away" =

ANGER (v. 26)

- because of some personal **H**_____ rather than for the sake of Christ's glory and honor.

To be angry and not sin, we must be angry at nothing but sin!
