- 1. These things really are T\_\_\_\_\_.**
  
- 2. Truth demands a personal R\_\_\_\_\_.**
  - a. Appreciating God's W\_\_\_\_\_.** (Neg. 8:5-6)
  - b. Agreeing with God's D\_\_\_\_\_.** (1 Kings 1:36-37)
  - c. Joining in God's P\_\_\_\_\_.** (Psa. 41:13; 72:19; 89:52; 106:48)
  
- 3. Truth is ultimately wrapped up in J\_\_\_\_\_.** (Rev. 3:14)
